Solutions by PP&S and Gusher

For Tenneco and Yamaha

These Gusher Self-Primers replaced Esco self priming centrifugal pumps at Tenneco in Hartwell, Georgia in March, 2012 and have been operating reliably for over one year. The end user has clogged the inlet line several times with trash, but they have not failed... neither seals, check valve, or other components. They simply removed obstructions from the suction line and were back in operation trouble free shortly after. A second identical assembly was purchased at same time and is operating trouble free in a separate sump service, also for overa year, while a third identical assembly was purchased by Tenneco as spare in early 2013. All assemblies were built and provided complete on bases, with motors, guards, etc. by the Gusher factory.









These Gusher ANSI pumps were sold to and installed at Yamaha in Newnan, Georgia. Their service is paint sludge system recirculation. They replaced vertical mount pumps. The pumps are primed via use of a foot valve.

Flexaseal single stationary bellows cartridge mounted mechanical seals were installed by Gusher factory with Plan 11 discharge recirculation piping to promote flow in the seal chamber.

Gusher provided the barrel adapter specified for alignment protection. The complete base mounted assembly with the motor and barrel adapter was built by the Gusher production team.

Fresh off the line, these Gusher SPP8 self priming / solids handling pumps are shipping to Toyota, in Georgetown, KY. They pump 1000 GPM at 55 TDH and are belt driven at approximately 1050 RPM's with premium, efficient, Baldor motors: 30 HP at 1800 RPM.


